CALL TO ORDER. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Carli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

CAT/RAT ISSUES.

Discussion was held regarding rats in the Village. Bob Villiard was present to voice concerns and stated that the rats would be around as long as there is a location for them. Discussion was held regarding this issue including the demolition of vacant old buildings in the Village.


Regarding Cats. Kim Cook prepared information for the Board to review on trap, neuter, and release. President Carli added that the Board is considering a Cat Licensing process that ensures the public safety of residents by requiring licensed cats to have a rabies vaccination. Bob would check with his veterinarian on the process of administering shots to cats and get back to the board. The Board will review all the information presented by Kim Cook and by Bob Villiard and will make a decision at the regular meeting on December 11, 2017.

RECYCLING ORDINANCE. Andy informed the board that if we do not adhere to the recycling ordinances, we will not receive funding for recycling. A revised ordinance draft was discussed with final approval slated for the December 11, 2017 regular board meeting.

DEMOLITION OF VACANT PROPERTIES. There are no longer grants available for this in the state. Buildings with shingles need to be demolished properly. Andrew will continue to look into ways to resolve this issue.
