A Resolution Reaffirming the Village of Radisson's Support for Fair Housing

LET IT BE KNOWN TO ALL PERSONS of the Village of Radisson that it reaffirms its support for fair housing opportunities for all persons as cited in Title VIII of the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Fair Housing Act), as amended, which prohibits discrimination in the sale, rental, and financing of dwellings, and in other housing-related transactions, based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status (including children under the age of 18 living with parents or legal custodians, pregnant women, and people securing custody of children under the age of 18), and disability. Therefore, the Village of Radisson does hereby pass the following Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that within available resources of the Village of Radisson, all persons who feel that they have been discriminated against in any housing or real estate purchase, conveyance or transaction based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status (including children under the age of 18 living with parents or legal custodians, pregnant women, and people securing custody of children under the age of 18), and disability, are encouraged to seek equity under federal and state laws by filing a complaint with the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development or the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Village will make complaint forms available upon request.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village of Radisson shall publicize this Resolution and through posting and distribution, the Village of Radisson shall cause residents, owners of real estate, builders, developers, and mortgage lenders to become aware of their respective responsibilities and rights under Federal Fair Housing legislation, and all other applicable state or local laws or ordinances.
