

Village of Radisson Charter Ordinance No. [1.03R]

A Charter Ordinance to Repeal and Replace Charter Ordinance No. 1.03 to Separate the Offices of Clerk and Treasurer, Provide for the Appointment of both Officers, and Providing for Audit of Accounts by the Village of Radisson as Deemed Necessary by the Board.

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2016, the Village adopted Charter Ordinance No. 1.03, which reaffirmed a charter ordinance adopted in 1994, combining the offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0101; and

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2016 the Village adopted Charter Ordinance No. 1.03, which reaffirmed a charter ordinance adopted in 1994, providing for the appointment of the Village Clerk-Treasurer by the Village Board;

WHEREAS, the duties and responsibilities of the Clerk-Treasurer have increased such that the Village Board has determined those duties and responsibilities can be most efficiently performed by a separate Clerk and Treasurer, rather than a single individual.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Radisson, Sawyer County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section One: The Village of Radisson, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 61.195 and 66.0101, hereby repeals Charter Ordinance No. 1.03.

Section Two: Following the effective date of this Charter Ordinance, the Village President shall appoint a Village Clerk and a Village Treasurer, subject to confirmation by the Village Board to serve a term commencing upon appointment. The presently serving Village Clerk-Treasurer shall continue to serve in said office until a Village Clerk and Village Treasurer are both appointed and qualified.

Section Three: The appointed Village Clerk shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal as provided for in Wis. Stat. §17.13.

Section Four: The appointed Village Treasurer shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal as provided for in Wis. Stat. § 17.13.

Section Five: The Village Treasurer shall perform all duties required by Wisconsin law, Village ordinances, and those other duties as the Village Board directs to be executed by the Village Treasurer from time to time.

Section Six: The Village Clerk shall perform all duties required by Wisconsin law, Village ordinances, and those other duties as the Village Board directs to be executed by the Village Clerk from time to time.

Section Seven: Audits shall be made of the records of the Village Treasurer with the audit to be made by a certified public accountant and as deemed necessary by the Village Board.

Section Eight: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Nine: This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its passage and publication as provided for by Wis. Stat. § 66.0101, unless within such sixty (60) days a referendum petition shall be filed as provided by Wis. Stat. § 66.0101(5), in which even this Charter Ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Section Ten: The Village Clerk-Treasurer shall cause this Charter Ordinance to be published as a class 1 notice, under chapter 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and shall file a certified copy of this Charter Ordinance with the Wisconsin Secretary of State.
