

## ORDINANCE

–To Adopt Ch. 8.02 of the Village Code;  
To Establish All-Terrain Vehicle Routes  
Within the Village of Radisson–

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF RADISSON HEREBY ORDAINS AS  
FOLLOWS:

**Section One:** That § 8.02 of the Village Code be adopted to read:

- 8.02.01 That the following named streets in the Village shall be designated as all-terrain vehicle routes, between those areas posted as such with all-terrain vehicle route signs:
- All of the streets and avenues within the Village limits with the following exceptions:
- 1) Omaha St (Highway 27/70)
  - 2) Clark St. (Highway 40) from Omaha St (Highway 27/70) south to Church St.
- 8.02.02 The speed limit on all-terrain vehicles shall not exceed 20 miles per hour while operating on all Village streets. Note: State law restricts all-terrain vehicle speed to 10 miles per hour within 150 feet of a dwelling between the hours of 10:30 pm and 7:00 am.
- 8.02.03 All-terrain vehicles shall operate on the extreme right side of the right of way or street and travel with the flow of traffic.
- 8.02.04 All-terrain vehicles are to be operated in single file.
- 8.02.05 All-terrain vehicle operators shall yield the right-of-way to all other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
- 8.02.06 Headlights shall be turned on and in working order at all times while operating on the street or shoulder.
- 8.02.07 Operators of all-terrain vehicles violating any of the above conditions will be subject to the underlying violation of illegally operating on the street or shoulder.
- 8.02.08 Operators of all-terrain vehicles travel at their own risk, and the Village of Radisson will not be liable for any damages or injuries to operators of all-terrain vehicles occurring in the Village of Radisson.

8.02.09 The Sawyer County Sheriff's Department is hereby designated as the law enforcement agency responsible for enforcing the provisions of this Ordinance.

8.02.10 The penalty for violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance is set forth in §23.33, Wis. Stats., as adopted by reference.

**Section Two:** That this ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
